Who May Enter

Entries submitted by any student enrolled in a public or private elementary school. Grades 4th and 5th

Timeline

- **February 22 ~ 28, 2010:** Hand in your participation form/request for poster paper
- **March 17, 2010:** Poster submission deadline
- **March 22, 2010:** Announce poster contest winners
- **April 7, 2010:** Winners' reception

When Can Posters Be Drawn?

Posters can be drawn anytime between February 22, 2010 and the deadline of March 17, 2010.

Poster Specifications

Completed poster size must be 9×12(inch) only. Age and grade level should be listed on the entry form. Please print clearly.

- There is no limitation on the type of media -- such as print, crayon, felt pen, etc. -- used on the poster design; however, wood, plastic, glass or metal should not be part of the poster. Collage materials should not be used. Glued on pieces will eliminate the poster.
- Poster designs may not incorporate any copyrighted characters (i.e., comic and/or television characters), photographs, magazine or newspaper illustrations.

Poster Themes must be Original

Poster themes must be original, ***Nutrition from the Ground Up*** concept and the exclusive work of the student entering the contest in idea, design and execution. Poster and slogan must harmonize with the theme: "***Nutrition from the ground up***"
